3D Visualization, Simulation, and Training in Defense to Grow to \$20 Billion

Vancouver, Wa. - Acacia Research Group announced its latest market brief, "Opportunities in 3D Visualization, Simulation, & Training 2010-2015: Defense & Government Market Snapshot." This snapshot provides a macro view of the market for technologies that enable military, emergency response, planning, and other government agencies to conduct training and education, data analysis, system simulation, and similar virtual tasks through the use of 3D computer graphics systems.
